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e) 14/03043/ADV Co-operative, Cornhill Market Place, East Street, Ilminster, TA19 0AW

The display of 3 No. internally illuminated fascia signs and 1 No. internally illuminated projection sign. (GR 336153/114562)

Issues discussed during consideration of this item included:

- Similar previous applications have been refused
- Size of the signs
- Not in keeping with surrounding buildings
- The application location is next to a listed building
- The signs and their lighting would be intrusive
- Night time economy
- Internal illumination
- Opening hours sign not in keeping with conservation area.
- The Town Council agree with the Conservation Officers comments **RECOMMEND REFUSAL** on the following grounds:
 - that the proposal is not in keeping with the Conservation area
 - there is no night time economy in Ilminster that requires illuminated signage
 - Internal illumination of signs is not in keeping with location within the Conservation Area
 - The proposed opening hours sign is out of keeping with the location

f) 14/03198/FUL, The Cricket Pavilion, The Recreation Ground, The Mead, Ilminster, TA19 0HG

Alterations to existing sports pavilion and provision of disabled access. (GR 335780/114209) Issues discussed during consideration of this item included:

- the proposed external ramp implies that access to the disabled toilet is only need for wheelchair users
- disabled access to the building
- Surface of ramp needs to be non-slip
- No lighting for ramp
- Health and Safety concerns such as steps near the disabled toilet do not appear to have any barriers or handrails
- Disabled toilet is only accessible from outside of the building,
- movement within the building for those with a disability does not appear to have been given sufficient thought
- Non-compliance with equality legislation e.g. door widths, gradients of ramp
- Concern consultation and permissions may not have been sought from leaseholders who will be impacted by the proposals
- The proposed path has access across a cycle path
- Use of the proposed path by vehicles
- Any path route and construction material need to be in accordance with the Town Council's master plan for the Open Spaces comprising the Wharf Lane Recreation Ground, The IEF Land and Britten's Field
- Section 17 Crime and Disorder Act Ramp could be used for skateboard users as near to Ilminster Skate Park and as a hanging out place for drinking

RECOMMEND REFUSAL but with the comment that the Town Council would like this application to move forwards as the cricket facility is in need of modernization and the Town Council would therefore be happy to discuss in detail the issues highlighted and would also suggest that the Somerset Disability Forum be consulted

RESOLVED that the Town Clerk write to the Secretary of the Cricket Club, with a copy to the Ilminster Education Foundation to inform of them of the Town Council's concerns

100. Road Closure

A Temporary Road Closure is in place at Listers Hill which commenced 6th August 2014 and was expected to last for 7days to enable preparation works and re-surfacing to be carried out in this road.

Issues discussed during consideration of this item included:

- Several road closures at one time in the town, which caused havoc for road users.
- Road signs not placed in correct locations.
- Emergency vehicles access.
- Some residents had been "trapped" in the housing area that they lived and unable to get out because they believed the road was completely closed
- It would have been possible to sign and undertake the work in stages
- Use of traffic lights may have been better and improved access and traffic flow
- In the Listers Hill area by the new houses a trench had been dug and backfilled but the surface was substantially below the road level resulting in a severe danger to vehicles that was unsigned

RESOLVED that the Town Council write a letter to Somerset County Council to express the disappointment in the signage arrangements.

101. Update on New Road Closure

The Chair provided an oral update resulting from Area West Committee.

It was reported that the Area West Committee were dissatisfied with Somerset County Council and the length of time it has taken to move the process forward to enable New Road to open. The Committee were informed that compensation for businesses from the County Council is unlikely. Issues discussed during consideration of this item included:

• Cllr Taylor reported that Information is shortly to be circulated with regards to a possible bid opportunity to help promote the town when New Road has opened

102. Maintenance of Gullies

The Chair provided an oral update on the jetting of gullies and road drains that has undertaken to improve maintenance.

Issues discussed during consideration of this item included:

- Several drains and gullies have been cleared, including Ditton Street but it is still not good working order.
- Drain by Gooch and House go Ltd has been maintained and is now fully working
- The gullies at Knott Oak have been jetted but there is still surface water laying on the road after heavy rainfall
