Title: Cemetery Grass Cutting Contract

Purpose of Report

Members to consider whether to go to tender for a new grass cutting contract for the cemetery or to bring the grass cutting back in-house to be done by the grounds staff.

Recommendation:

Members resolve to bring the grass cutting at the cemetery back in-house to be carried out by the Town Council's grounds staff.

Report:

- 1. A few years ago, the grass cutting of the cemetery was completed by the Town Council Wardens. After losing staff, a contract was made with South Somerset District Council for a year, and this was then followed by a two-year contract with Willoway Landscaping Services.
- 2. The current grass cutting contract for the cemetery is approximately £400 per month and is due to finish at the end of March 2022.
- 3. The scope of the work in the current contract comprises:
 - To cut the grass 18 times per year:
 - 2 cuts per month from April to October
 - 2 cuts in the period November to December
 - 2 cuts in the period Jan to March
 - To clear and remove all cuttings
 - To brush or blow any loose grass off headstones and kerbstones
 - To agree a schedule of visits in advance and give as much notice as possible of any changes (eg. due to weather)
- 4. The Countryside Manager had already discussed this idea with the team as they will have spare capacity to be able to cover this particularly during the summer months.
- 5. At this stage, the grounds team would not require any more equipment to carry out the work.
