Widening Pathway

Size of area 47 x 1.3 metres alongside existing path and 7 x 2 metres in front of workshop side door. (Highlighted in orange on the attached plan.)

Soil to be dug out to 300mm deep. Base of 150mm crushed stone or scalpings compacted down. Topped with 150mm concrete.

Area outside Workshop, Stores and Compound

Size of area 6 x 27 metres. (Highlighted in yellow on the attached plan.) Drainage pipe to be laid along whole length of area and connected to manhole.

Section of topsoil 27 x 6 metres to be dug out to depth of 300mm. 100mm of crushed stone (wacked down). 50mm of scalpings 40 to dust (wacked down).

Contractor's quote for above

£1750

162 square metres of honeycomb style matting (to be infilled with top soil and seeded with grass).

Costs for matting range from £1650 to £2300. There may be extra costs for delivery and mesh underlay.

The work on this area could therefore be carried out for an approximate cost of £4000.
