

**Warden's Report
Open Spaces Committee 17 February 2015**

Jobs Done Since the Last Committee Meeting

- We have started to edge the cemetery paths
 - Planted bulbs with:-
Isle Valley pre school
Cheeky monkeys
and the Scouts/Cubs and Beavers
 - Put out a new bench base and bench in Britten's Field
 - Rubbed down, re-painted, sanded and stained the GWR bench on Canal Way and refitted
 - Burnt the rubbish by means of a bonfire at Cleaves Close
 - Removed the canal outlet frame and lowered the height on the pipe the angling club put in, the water level is now below the path for the first time in a while
 - Rolled the football pitches
 - Had a demo of a possible mule replacement
 - Put wood chippings at the entrance gateways on the rec, etc.
 - Finished the inventories for the bins and benches
 - 44 litter bins,
 - 23 dog bins,
 - 4 salt bins and
 - 90 benches/picnic tables
- We are responsible for them all, but don't empty 22 of the bins or fill the salt bins.
- Normal day to day jobs, litter picking/emptying bins, etc.

Future jobs planned

- Thin trees on Herne Hill
- Coppice section of hedge on the ridge path
- Continue putting benches and remaining bench bases out
- Cemetery - make up graves that have sunk, finish trimming shrubs, etc.
- Carrying on tidying up pathways
- Work with volunteer to start tending some of the neglected graves
- Tidying up Burma Star garden
