The subjects discussed were:

Fair Trade Town status

This now been granted to Ilminster but the public announcement of the award will be made at various events throughout the town during FAIRTRADE Fortnight, which this year runs from 23rd February to 8th March, and a formal presentation will be made by the Steering Group to the Mayor and Town Councillors at the annual Ilminster Town Assembly on 21st April.

Flooding Money

It is proposed that money received to compensate for the downturn in business in the town due to flooding in the surrounding areas should used to advertise the town on the Breeze and in the Yeovil Press.

First Tuesday/Loyalty Card

The First Tuesday event was discussed in some detail, as there has been a fall in business membership. It was agreed to continue for the moment and at the same time pursue the idea of an Ilminster loyalty card. The promise of sponsorship for such a card has now been received.

The Town App

Cosmic have agree to give training on the Town App, how to access the site and load up data relevant to the individual shops. A working/social event is to be arranged to enable this to happen.
