Ilminster Town Council would like to put forward the following suggestions for possible inclusion into the revised Conservation Area for Ilminster.

We would be happy to walk the areas with you if necessary and put forward the view why they should be included.

Ensure that Ditton Street School playground is also included - not clear currently, but this is an integral part of the old school.

Cottages at Cross (row) - western side of road.

Knott Oak House.

The curtilage of the grammar school playing field and main lab hut, to be included as part of the old Ilminster Grammar School site..

Love Lane, including area north of the road, the row of cottages running south, and the listed two cottages on the southern end; row of cottages on eastern side at end of lane; this also to include the remaining larger wall on the eastern/northern side which has just recently been opened for car parking; this wall should remain an intact part of the conservation area setting for this part of the town and this interesting and characterful small town lane, including the ginnel (Upper Love Lane) to junction of East Street / Bay Hill.

Wall along Butts opposite Blackdown View (north of Area 13 - this was the subject of much controversy in the 1980s when part was demolished).

Town allotments.

Cottages beyond Area 3 at the Beacon.

Cottage opposite Tesco filling station in Ditton Street.

Town cemetery.

The canal and incline.

Summervale House Brewery Lane (NAME TO BE CONFIRMED)

The toll house on the western extremity of Station Road.

Area 12 to be reconsidered - this does not appear to be the recent development off Frog Lane (old map).

Further check of the south side of Area 13 to make sure the Gooch and House site is not compromised - currently it appears that some of those buildings are not included in the CA but they might well be the more modern warehouse type buildings.
