Police Town Council Report

Town Council meeting 21st May.

Firstly, I would like to congratulate you all on being elected to the Town Council. Many of you I know already and many I will get to know over the coming months.

Since the last report, the following things of note have occurred:

12 theft type offences at various locations, these include 4 making off without payment from petrol stations.

6 Criminal damage offences, 2 on vehicles, 4 on various types of property. 1 was damage to an election party board. Another was damage to a tree, whereby the offender is under the age of criminal responsibility.

There were 4 violence against the person offences, 2 of which were assault PC.

3 sexual offences, in all of these, the victim knew the suspect, all have been arrested. 1 was a historic offence.

There has been 3 fraud type offences, 1 was a fake £20 note, used to pay for goods, another where a male tricked a cashier into returning money for goods which were not purchased there, and the third where a male bought items from a man in a car, and they were not what he thought he was buying.

There has been one drugs seizure (cannabis possession)
